Dose assessments are typically required in asbestosis and asbestos-related lung cancer cases, with dose-based apportionments also required in pleural thickening and, where applicable, pleural plaques cases. Recent attention has also been drawn to the potential for doses assessment being required in low exposure mesothelioma cases.
